Graduate Major in Materials and Information Sciences Application Guidelines for Eligibility Screening

1. Application eligibility

Master's students from outside Institute of Science Tokyo who meet both of the following criteria (1) and (2)

- (1) Students who plan to enter the Science Tokyo doctoral degree program in September 2025.
- (2) Students who plan to belong to one of the following departments after enrolling in the doctoral degree program:

Physics / Chemistry / Electrical and Electronic Engineering / Materials Science and Engineering / Chemical Science and Engineering / Computer Science /Life Science and Technology / Transdisciplinary Science and Engineering (There may be additional departments on the list.)

* The intended academic supervisor of a student enrolling in this graduate major must be assigned as the major's principal or secondary instructor by the time of the student's application to the doctoral degree program.

2. Start of Enrollment

From September 2025.

3. Eligibility screening procedure

- (1) Document screening
- (2) Selected applicants contacted for interview

4. Important dates

- Application period: June 19 to June 26, 2025
 (Application documents must arrive by 17:00 on Thursday, June 26, 2025)
- (2) Document screening: July 1 to July 18, 2025
- (3) Interview: July 22 to August 1, 2025
 Applicants who pass the document screening will be contacted for an interview.
 Some applicants may be exempted from an interview based on the screening results.
- (4) Notification of screening results: August 5, 2025 (Friday) (tentative)

5. Application documents

The following must be completed and submitted by email to the Academy for Convergence of Materials and Informatics (TAC-MI) Administration Office by the application deadline:

- (1) Application Form for Eligibility Screening for the Graduate Major in Materials and Information Sciences
- 6. Applicants must send applications themselves, and CC their intended academic supervisor.
 - (2) Letter of Recommendation and Consent for the Graduate Major in Materials and Information Sciences
- 7. <u>Applicants must request that their intended academic supervisor prepare and submit a Letter of</u> <u>Recommendation and Consent via email to the TAC-MI Administration Office by the application</u> <u>deadline.</u>
